Parish Directory 2019

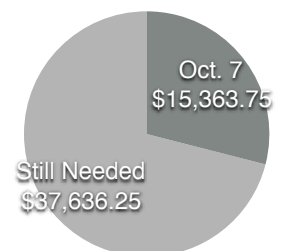
