## Youth Ministry Core Team

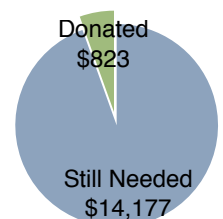

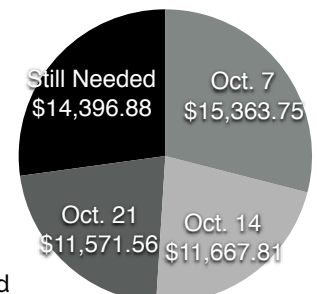
