Youth Ministry Core Team

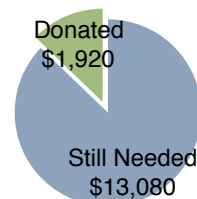

#Giving Tuesday

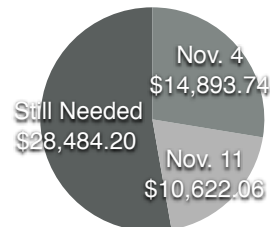
