Youth Ministry Core Team

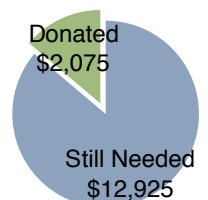

Kitchen Towel Roundup

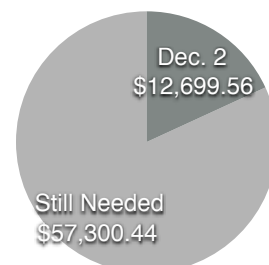
