## Youth Ministry Core Team

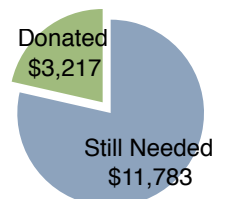

## St. Pat's Baptism Blanket Ministry

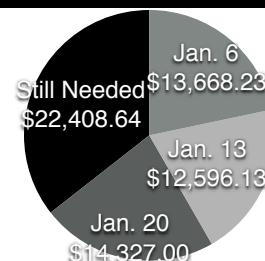
