Youth Ministry Core Team

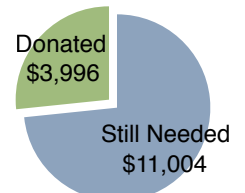

Lenten Retreat at Holy Spirit Center

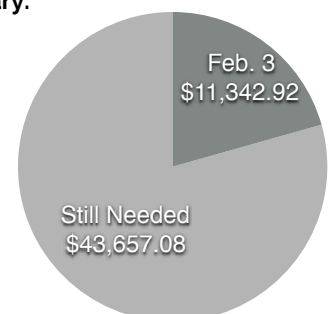
