## Youth Ministry Core Team

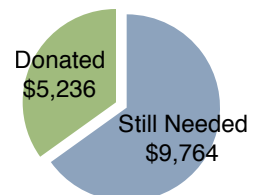

## Calling All Cooks

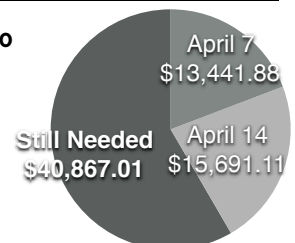
