## Seekers

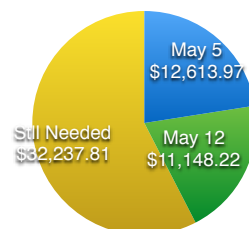

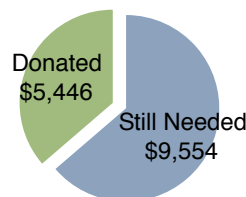
