Youth Ministry Core Team

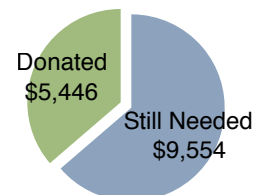

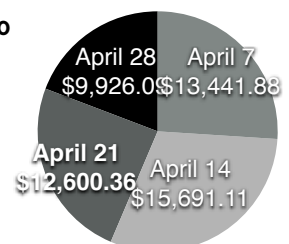
