Bereavement Ministry

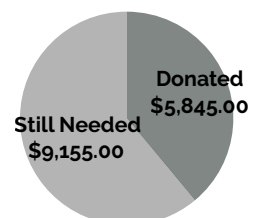

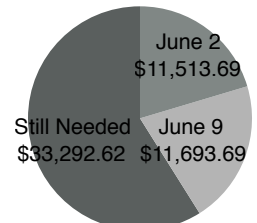
