Bereavement Ministry

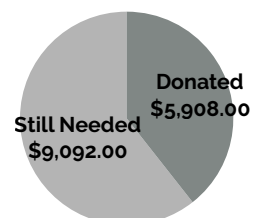

Seminarian Night Dinner and Fundraiser

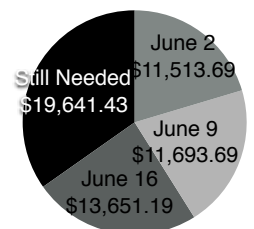
