Bereavement Ministry

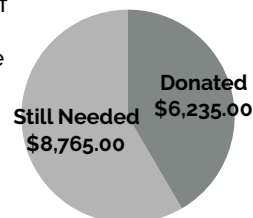

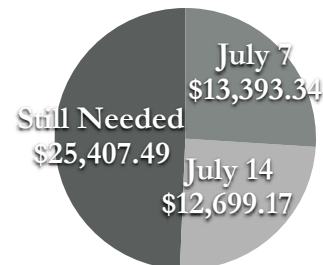
