Bereavement Ministry

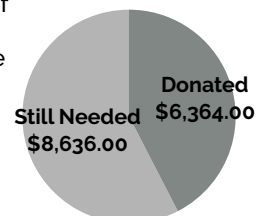

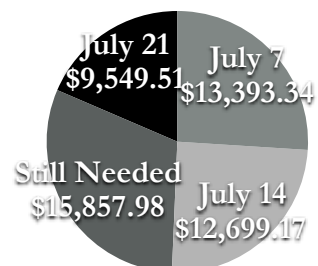
