Bereavement Ministry

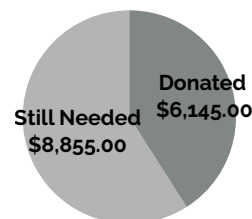

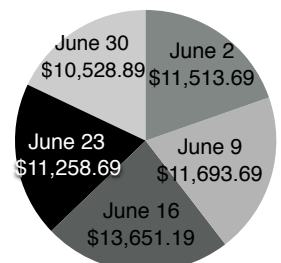
